

## **Campus East/West FAQ**

### **What is a “dual campus”?**

We have one school that uses two buildings

- Each building (or campus) offers the basic courses a student would need to graduate from high school
- Some option classes are specific to a particular campus (e.g. Instrumental music is at CCHS East and Pre-engineering is at CCHS West)

### **Do students regularly move between the two campuses?**

- Students will generally remain at one campus for a full quarter. Students will have the opportunity to move between campuses each quarter in order to allow them to fully access all programs to best meet their program needs.  
For example: Quarter 1 ó English and Physical Education ó Campus West Quarter 2 ó Religious Studies and Drama ó Campus East

### **Could a student take their entire high school program at one campus?**

- Yes. If all the courses a student wants are offered exclusively at one campus, a student may never need to move. However, we would hope that students take advantage of the opportunity to experience both campuses, and to interact with new people and explore a variety of programs.

### **How are students transported from one campus to the other?**

- Students travel to either campus using transit services as currently provided through the division, in cooperation with the City of Lethbridge. For the few students who need to travel between campuses during the day, a shuttle bus service runs at flex time.

### **Where do school events such as games or concerts take place?**

- We will always endeavor to have events take place at the facility best suited for the event.
- One of our aims is to ensure equitable use of both campuses in order to keep the sense of unity that is so much a part of the CCH experience.

### **How are staff divided between the two campuses?**

- Teaching staff are allocated to campuses depending on the needs of students and the timetable. As with students, it is possible that a teacher may spend an entire year at one campus, or may move between campuses from quarter to quarter.
- Both Campus East and Campus West have chapels.
- Counseling is available at both campuses during the day.
- Education assistants are allocated to both campuses depending on student needs.
